Requirements For Public Online Lottery License

- 1. Application Letter.**
- 2. Non-refundable Application Fee in the sum of ₦5,000,000 (Five Million Naira)**
- 3. Documentary Evidence of Business Incorporation**
 - i. Certificate of Incorporation .
 - ii. Memorandum and Articles of Association (object clause must cover betting facilitation, gaming promotion, digital advisory, or related services) .
 - iii. Minimum share capital of ₦30 ,000,000 (Thirty Million Naira Only) – CAC Status Report .
 - iv. Details of Directors and Shareholders .v. Address of registered office and operational address(es) .
- 4. Business Structure.**
 - i. Name and profile of all directors and management staff (at least one director or management staff must possess gaming industry experience).
 - ii. Tax Clearance Certificates of all directors for the preceding three (3) years.
 - iii. Address of planned locations, branches, and outlets.
 - iv. Description of operations and management structure.
 - v. Lottery industry analysis demonstrating understanding of the Nigerian lottery market, including major players and market share.
 - vi. Marketing and distribution plans.
- 5. Financial Information / Structure.**
 - i. Management accounts of the organization.
 - ii. Company bank statement for the last one (1) year in support of the financing plan.
 - iii. Five-year projected profit and loss account, balance sheet, and cash flow analysis (to provide for licence fees and applicable taxes).
 - iv. Capital budgets and financing plan, including source of funds, foreign investment (if any), and terms of investment.
- 6. Details of Proposed Lottery Operations.**
 - i. Proposed trademark, brand name, logo, and colours.
 - ii. Details and types of planned lottery games.
 - iii. Applicable odds or draw system.
 - iv. Price structure of lottery tickets.

- v. Frequency and number of draws.
- vi. Applicant's game rules and participants' code of practice.
- vii. Responsible gaming policies

7. Technical Structure.

Detailed information and profiles of technical service providers/partners, including but not limited to:

- Draw machine manufacturers and suppliers.
- Web hosting providers.
- Database and backup service providers.
- i. Architectural diagram clearly illustrating the technical operational flow.
- ii. Information on hardware infrastructure, including but not limited to:
 - Types of servers to be used.
 - Details of firewalls, routers, and other security features.
 - Redundancy and failover implementations (if any).
- iii. Detailed information on software infrastructure, including but not limited to:
 - Operating system specifications.
 - Database application specifications

8. Process and System Quality Assurance.

Evidence of system quality controls, internal processes, and operational integrity.

9. Gaming Laboratory Certification.

The Applicant's gaming platform shall be independently tested and certified by Global Lab Limited (Global Lab). The certification must confirm compliance with applicable technical, security, integrity, fairness, and operational standards for public online lottery systems. A valid certification report shall be submitted as part of the licence application.

10. SCUML Certification.

Evidence of registration and certification with the Special Control Unit Against Money Laundering (SCUML), in compliance with applicable AML/CFT regulations.

11. Bank Guarantee / Surety Bond.

A Bank Guarantee in the sum of ₦100,000,000.00 (One Hundred Million Naira) issued by a reputable financial institution or a duly executed Surety Bond acceptable to the Federation.

12. Service Level Agreements (SLA).

Duly executed copies of Service Level Agreements (SLAs) between the applicant and all technical service providers/partners must be submitted.

13. Letter of Introduction of Technical Service Providers.

Formal letters of introduction from all technical service providers and partners must be provided to ensure transparency and regulatory visibility.

NOTE:

Applicants are required to submit both hard copy and soft copy of their application documents on a USB storage device.
